



PUBLIC ENCOURAGED TO PROVIDE INPUT ON OGDEN TRANSIT PROJECT

Utah Transit Authority (UTA) and Ogden City are seeking input on a community transit project connecting downtown with Weber State University and McKay-Dee Hospital. The recommendation includes an alignment that begins at the Ogden Intermodal Station on 23rd Street to Washington Blvd and up 25th Street to Harrison Blvd, then through Weber State University, and ending at McKay-Dee Hospital. The proposal utilizes Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) with a modern design. The alignment includes a combination of mixed flow travel with street traffic and some lanes exclusive to BRT.

An open house will be held on Jul. 7, 2015, from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Ogden Municipal Building (2549 Washington Blvd., 3rd Floor). A transit presentation will be made during the City Council meeting at 6:00 p.m. and opportunity for public comment will follow. All received input will be taken into consideration and the Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA) will be considered during the City Council meeting on Jul. 28, 2015.

This proposal is consistent with the Wasatch Front Regional Council 2015-2040 Regional Transportation Plan. It has been developed by community stakeholders and through an extensive public involvement process, including more than 25 community group presentations, a regional phone survey, door to door conversations and an online forum.
