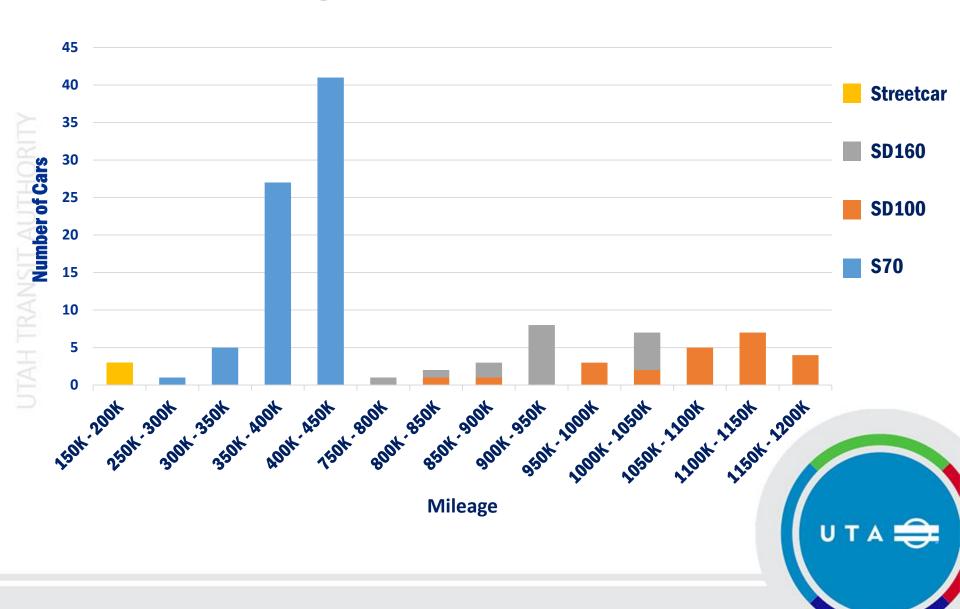

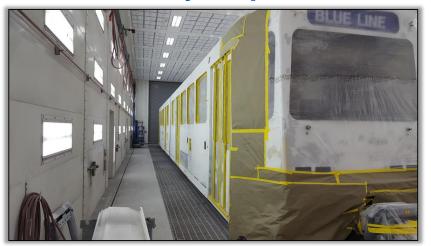

Contract: Joint Vendor Managed Inventory (The Aftermarket Parts Co.)

- Description and purpose:
 - Manage significant challenges in obtaining aftermarket parts due to long lead times, inflated pricing, availability, and obsolescence
 - UTA is partnering with San Diego Transit (SDMTS) and Portland Transit (Tri-Met) to jointly procure vendor managed inventory services
- Total contract:
